Take Advantage of your Upcoming Curbside Cleanup!

Use Marin Sanitary's upcoming **Curbside Cleanup Day** for your neighborhood to help prepare your property for the coming wildfire. Marin Sanitary will have curbside cleanups in San Rafael in August, September, and October. To get the date of your neighborhood curbside cleanup, check the "Billing Cycle" number on your bill and check their website for the correct cleanup date or call Marin Sanitary customer service at 415-456-2601. You also should have received a notice in the mail.

On your **Curbside Cleanup Day**, you can put out up to 14 30-gallon paper bags (or 32-gallon hardware store trash cans) of yard waste, compostables, or trash (plastic bags are ok for trash only). Home Depot sells the giant paper bags for about 50 cents each. Bags or cans must weigh no more than 60 pounds. **[Note: next year, Marin Sanitary will no longer accept hardware store cans because they cannot be lifted automatically and cause employee lifting injuries.]**

Paper bags are most useful for small or soft materials like leaves, pine needles, grass clippings, and hedge and flower trimmings. If you use the bags for tree and shrub branches, cut the branches into small sections before bagging them to keep from tearing your bag apart.
